Chairman Hagerty gave information on the Public Comment Period.

On September 25, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to completion, 250 backpacks will be filled by veterans for homeless veterans at the Veterans Center. On October 31, 2019 at Graceada Park there will be a Veterans Stand Down with a backpack giveaway. Department of Motor Vehicles and the Veterans Center will be in attendance as well as a medical bus, church shower bus, Congressman Josh Harder, employers, vet pets and dental services. International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers will provide a solar trailer. Lunch will also be provided.

A draft of the Veterans Resource Book is just about complete and ready to be reviewed. The book will be provided for review at the next meeting.

Employment Development Department (EDD) Local Veterans Employer Outreach Representative retired. Interviews were conducted to backfill the position. New hire expected start date is October 1, 2019.

The Veterans Parade will be at Graceada Park on November 11, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.

A. Veterans Overview

Workforce Development Director, Doris Foster reported Workforce Development will have a booth at the Veterans Stand Down and will be providing an item for the backpacks with contact information on how to contact the Department for services.

Workforce Development and three other counties were awarded the Veterans Employment Assistance Program Grant (VEAP). This Grant has since expired and was not extended. Departments are able to apply every two years. The Department will reapply once the Grant is available as well as continue to look at other veteran Grants that are available.

A. Approved and Enabled Staff to Provide Direction of a Veterans Job Fair With the Date to Be Provided.

Director, Doris Foster reported and provided statistics on who attended, the success, and outcomes of previous Veteran Job Fairs. It was reported, 69 percent of Veterans were employed after receiving services with an average wage of \$22.42 per hour in the 2018/2019 program year.

The May 2019 Veterans Job Fair was a great event. There were a total of 76 exhibitors, 59 employers with open positions, 8 apprenticeships/school programs, and 8 veteran service organizations. Congressman Josh Harder spoke and opened the event. Veterans received priority entrance and

registration. A computer lab with computers was available for job search. Resume and mock interview workshops were provided to assist with transferable skills. EDD and Opportunity Stanislaus provided outreach to employers. This event was a collaborative planning effort between Stanislaus County Workforce Development, EDD, Stanislaus County Office of Education, and Representative Josh Harder’s Office.

Staff to the Committee recommend a possible location change for the next Job Fair to the Veterans Center at 3500 Coffee Road, Modesto, CA to be held again in May on a weekday or weekend.

Richard Hagerty, Committee Chair recommended the next meeting be held on Thursday, December 12, 2019. He gave his closing remarks and thanked Congressman Harder’s office. The meeting was adjourned at 11:56 a.m.




VI. DISCUSSION:
