



### Light Hiring Competition Over an Average Supply of Regional Talent




**Supply (Jobs)**

Stanislaus County, CA is about average for this kind of talent. The national average for an area this size is 31,889\* employees, while there are 33,785 here.



**Earnings Per Job**

Earnings per job are about the same as the national average. Earnings per jobs is the total industry earnings divided by the number of jobs in the industry.



**Demand (Job Postings)**


Competition from online job postings is low in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 4,131\* job postings/mo, while there are 3,378 here.

# Supply (Jobs)


## Supply Is About Equal to the National Average



## Retirement Risk Is About Average, While Overall Diversity Is High




**Retiring Soon**

Racial diversity is high in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 13,498\* racially diverse employees, while there are 20,928 here.




**Gender Diversity**


## Unemployment Rate Trends


## Industry Age Breakdown



## Industry Race/Ethnicity Breakdown






## Top 15 Skills for All Job Types Sought by Your Selected Companies by Quarter
