## Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 0.2%** since 2019, growing by 857. Population is expected to **increase by 0.3%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 1,927.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 2.4%** in Stanislaus County, CA from 216,576 to **221,758**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 1.9%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 58.7% to 60.9% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.9% of Stanislaus County, CA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.6% below the national average), and **8.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.8% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Individual and Family Services.

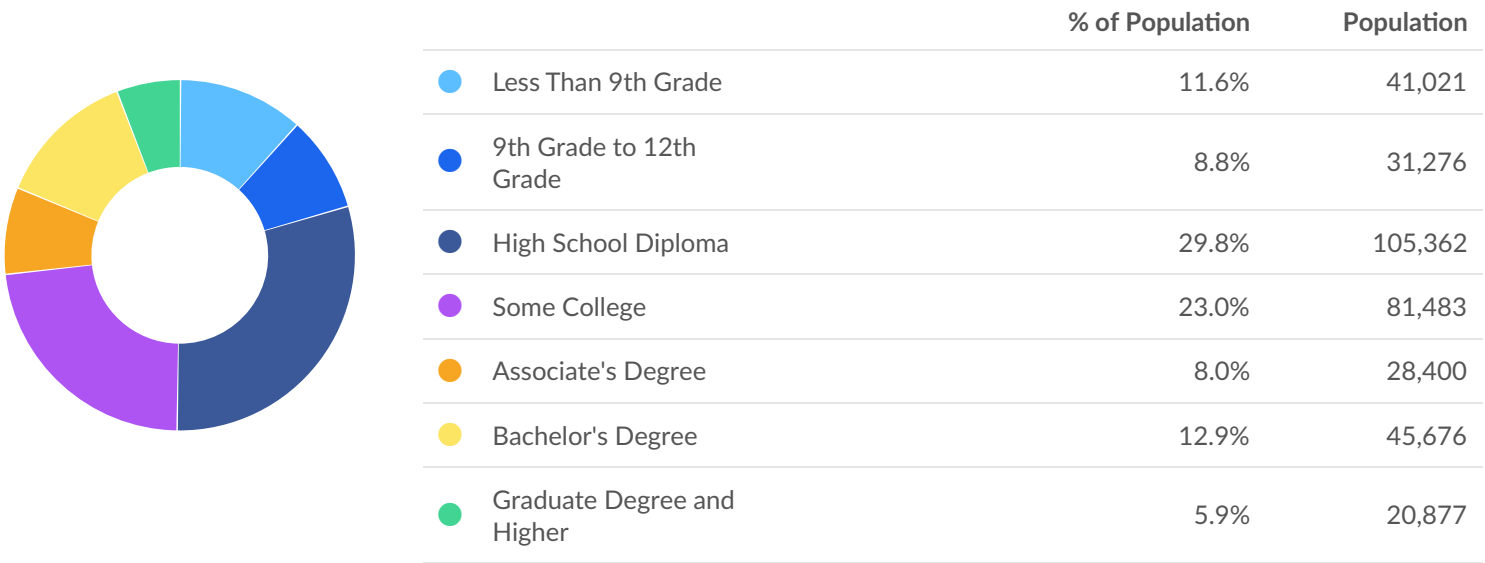

## Jun 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



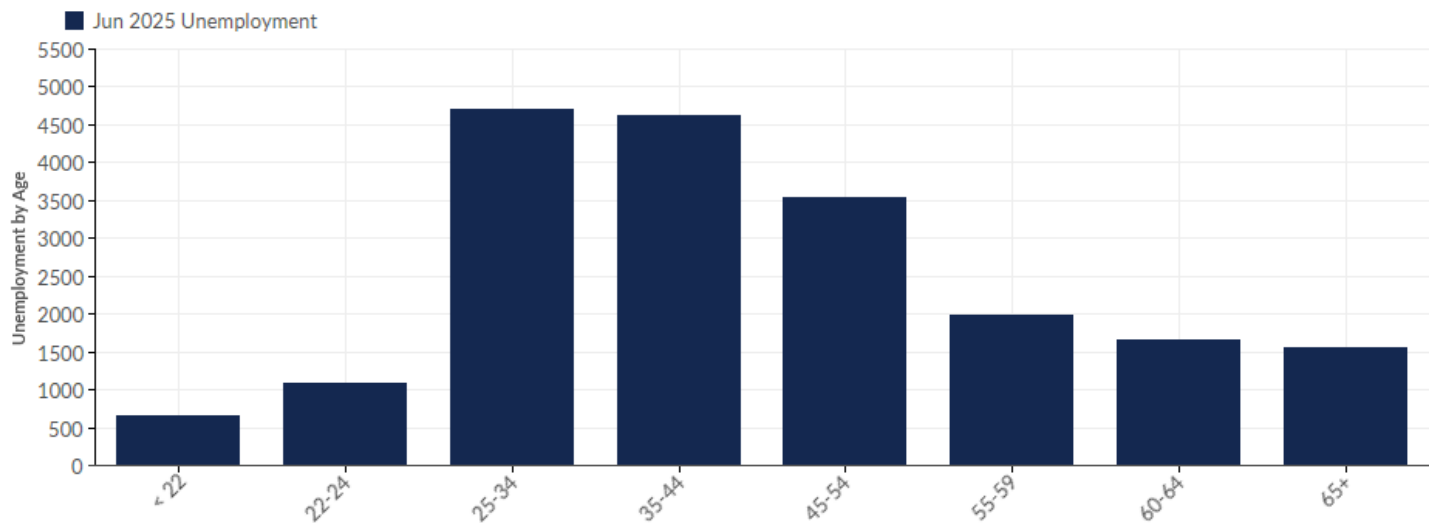
## Educational Attainment

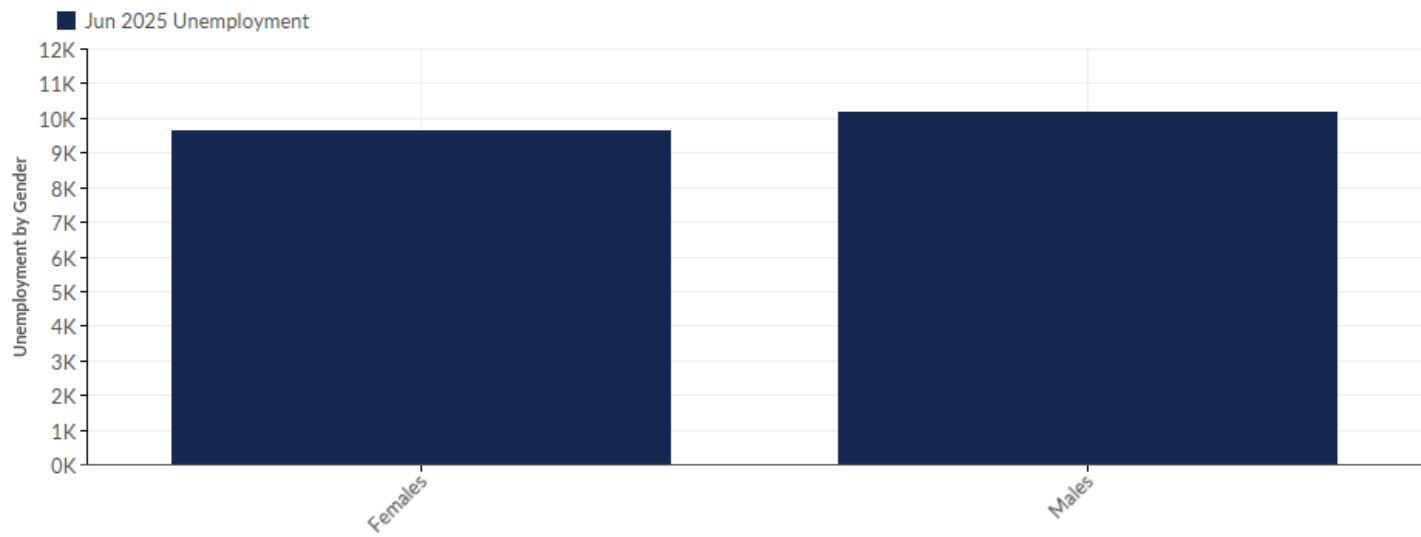

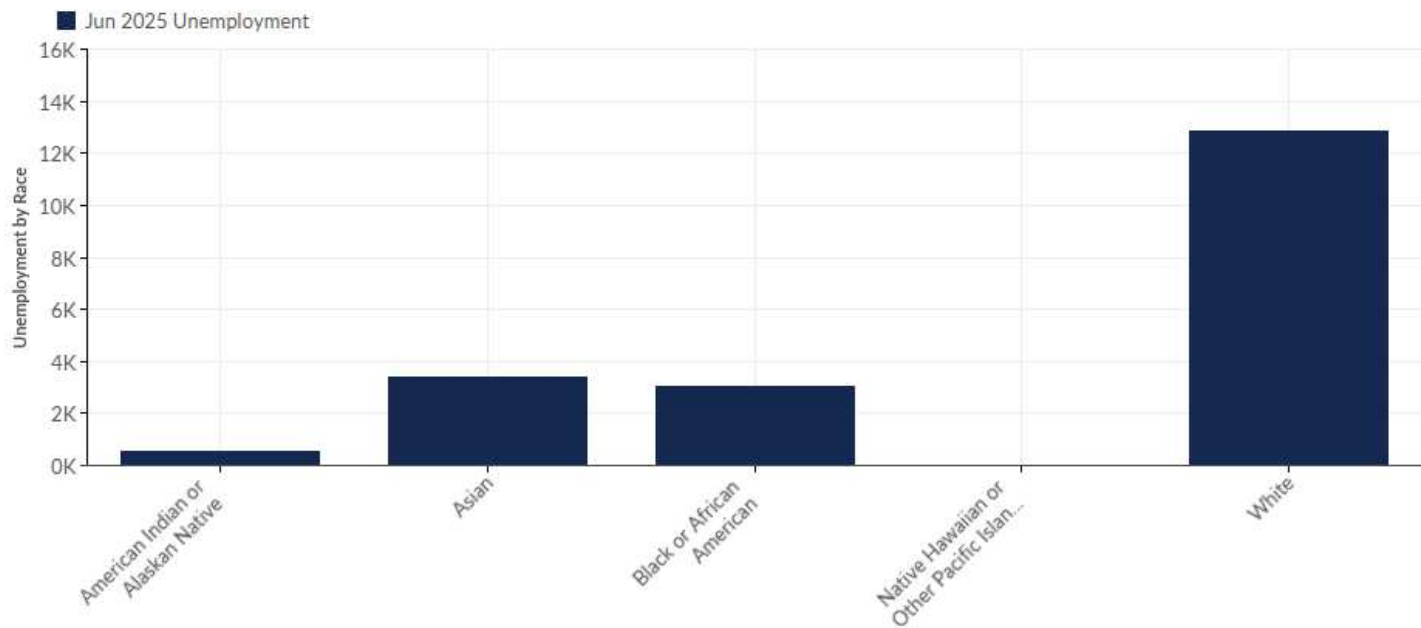

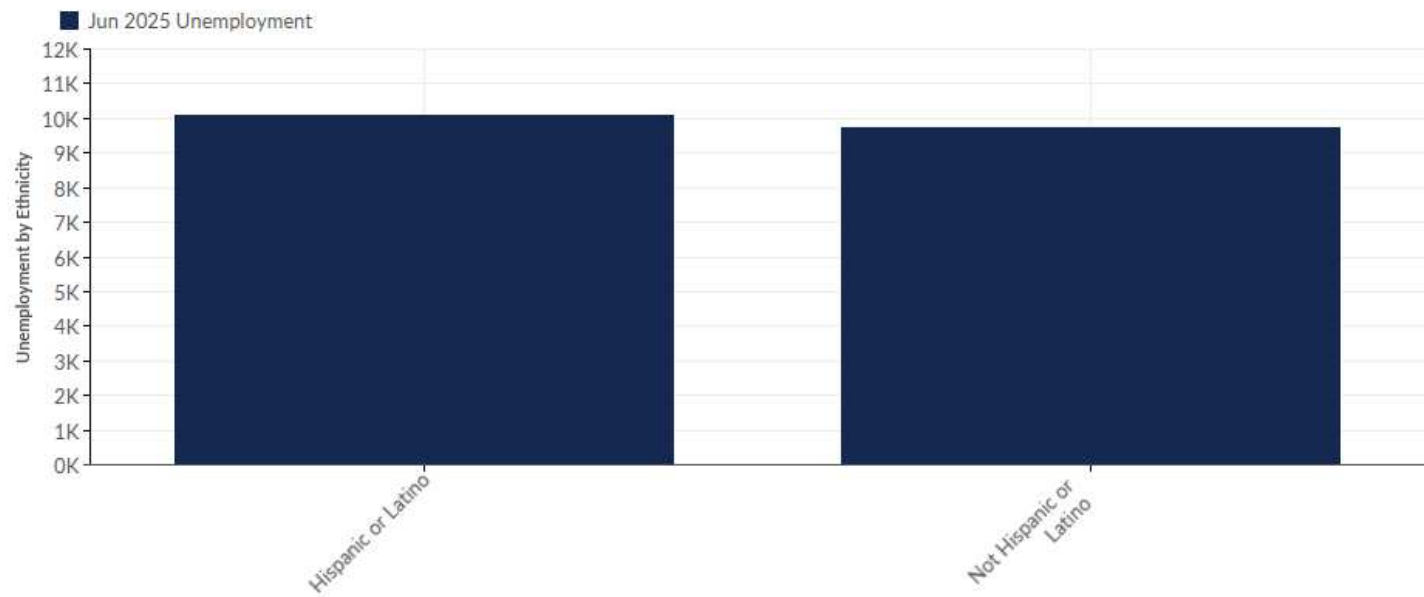

Unemployment by Ethnicity

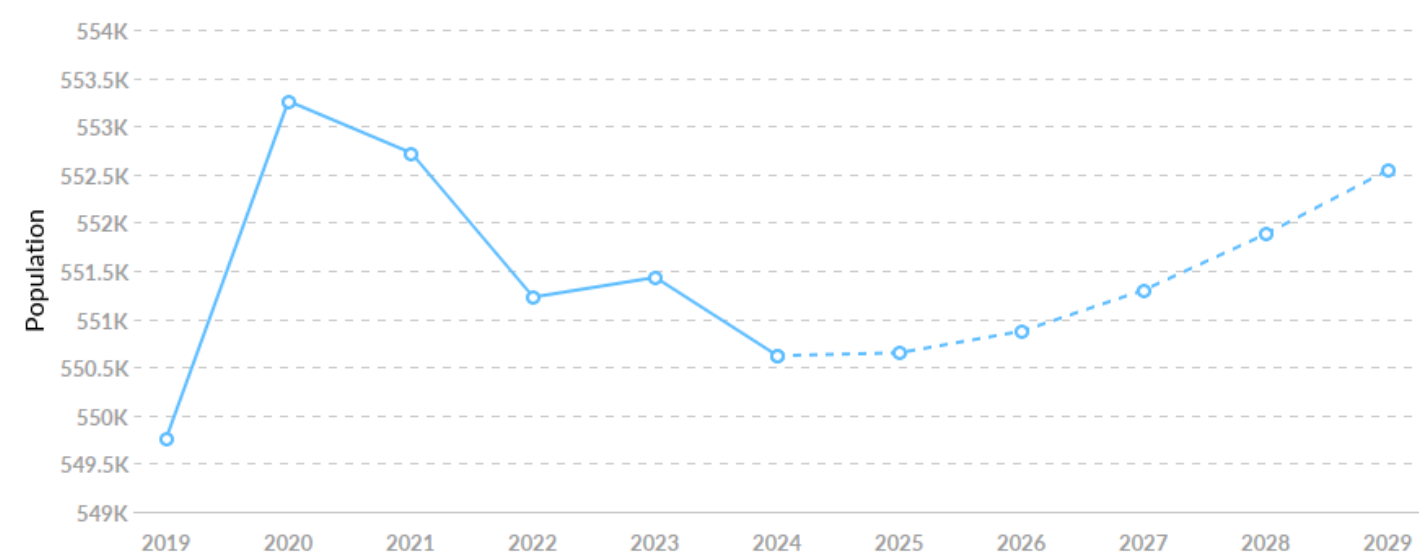

## Population Trends

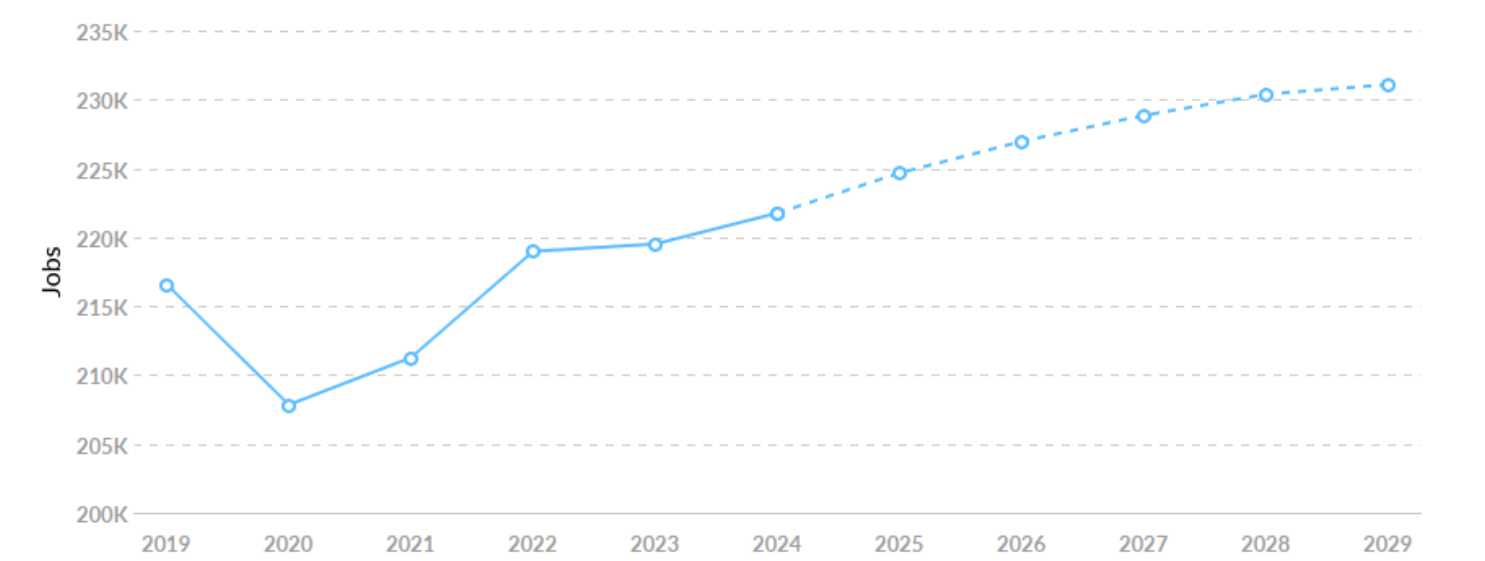

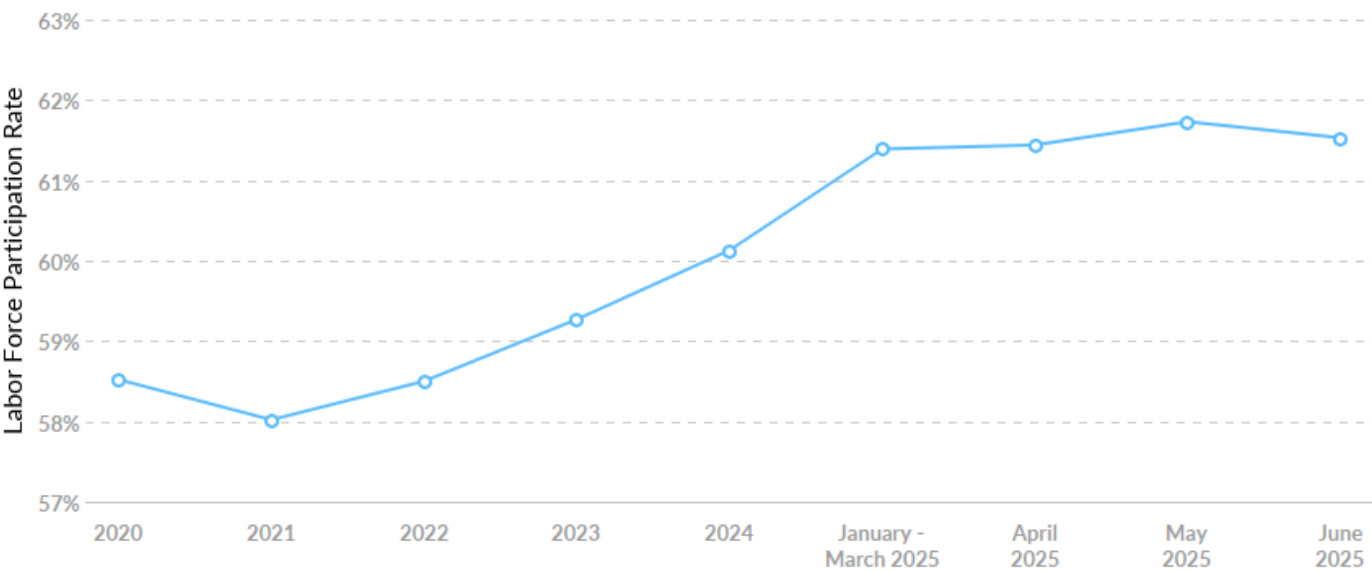
## Job Trends

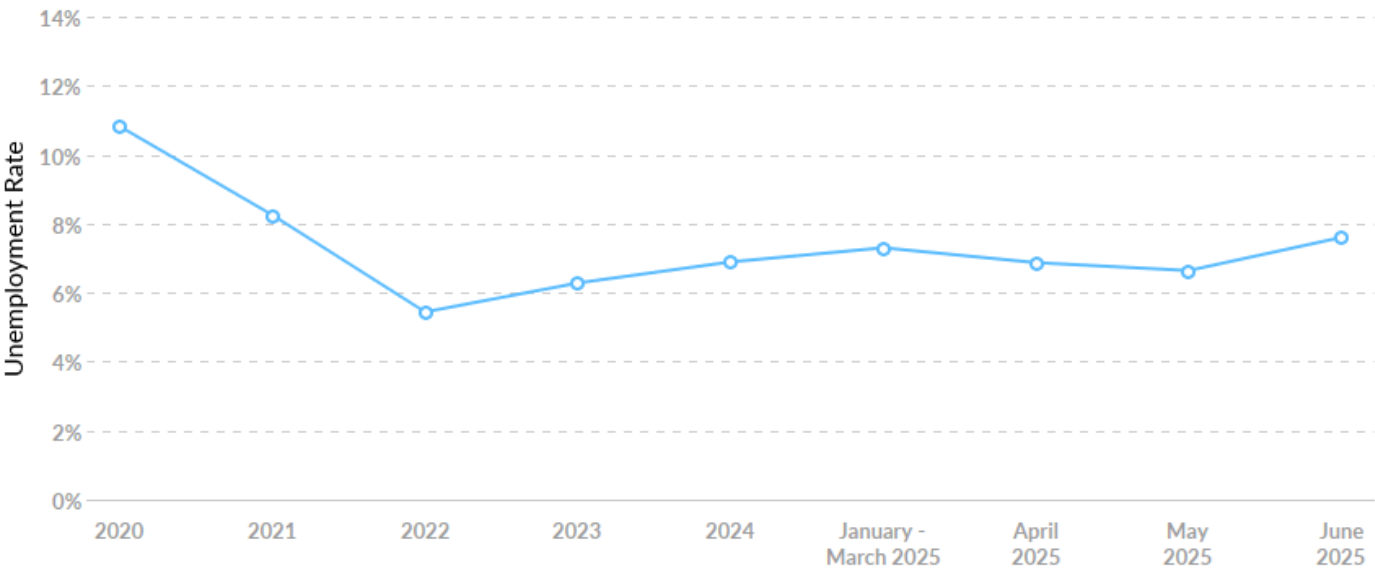

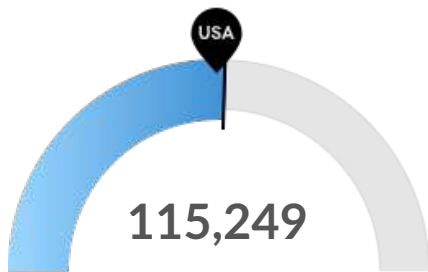
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Stanislaus County, CA had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 7.60%, **decreasing from 10.82%** 5 years before.



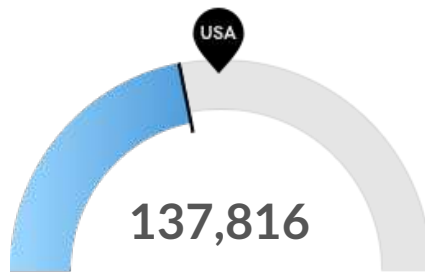

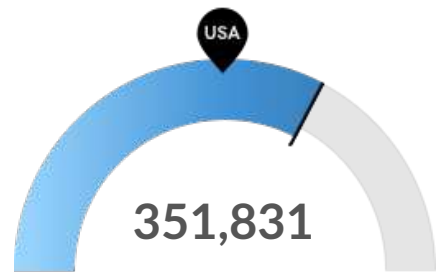
Millennials

Stanislaus County, CA has 115,249 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 112,041.



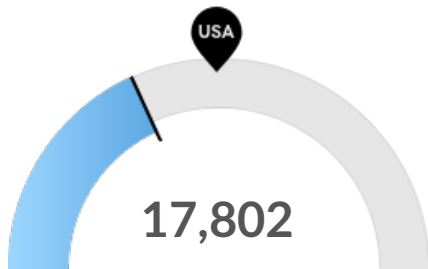
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 166,463 people 55 or older, while there are 137,816 here.



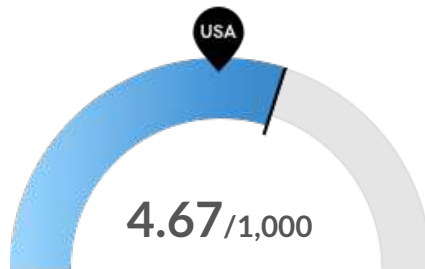
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 229,655 racially diverse people, while there are 351,831 here.



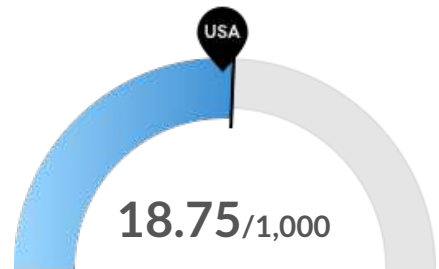
Veterans

Stanislaus County, CA has 4.67 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

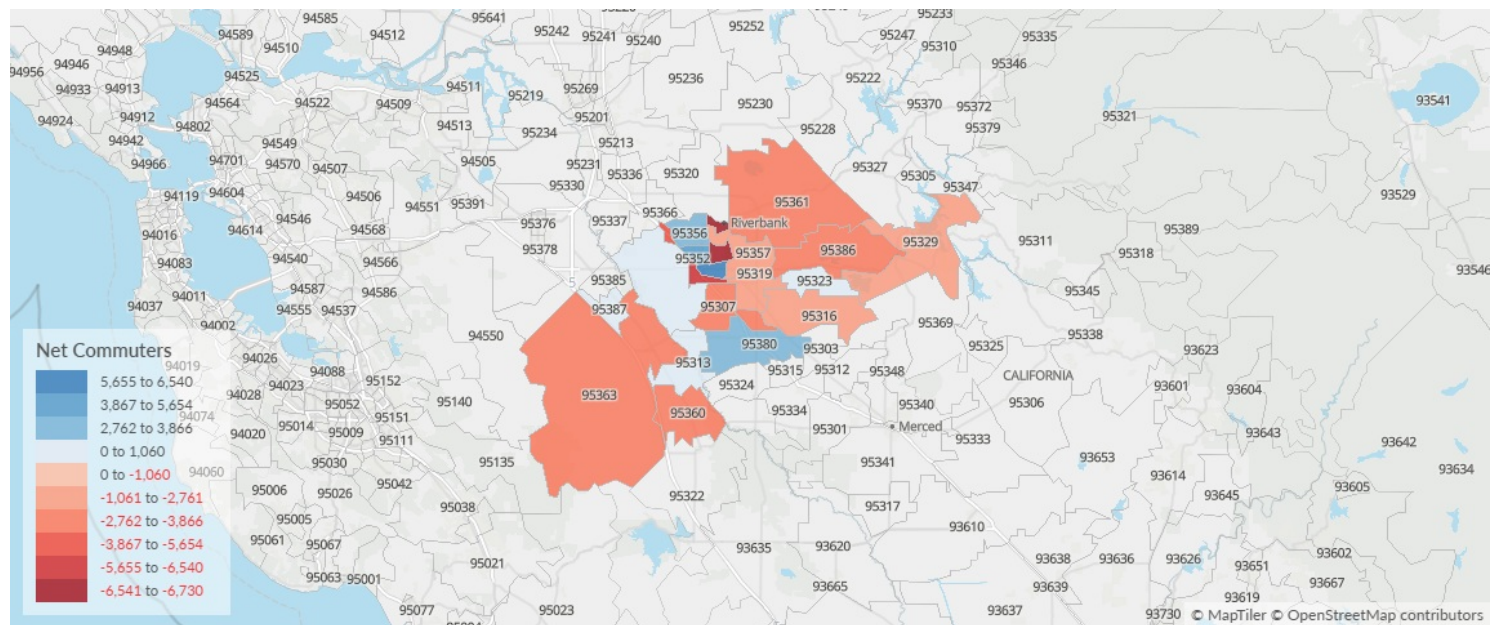


Property Crime

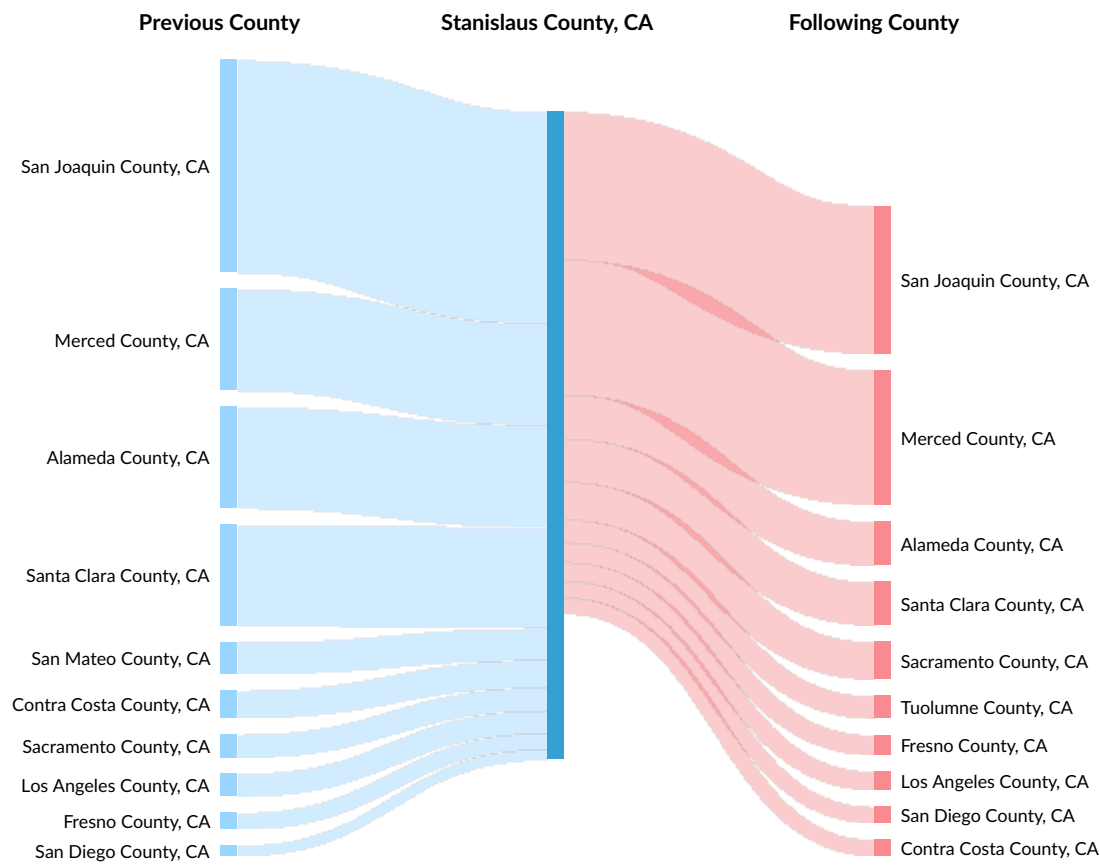

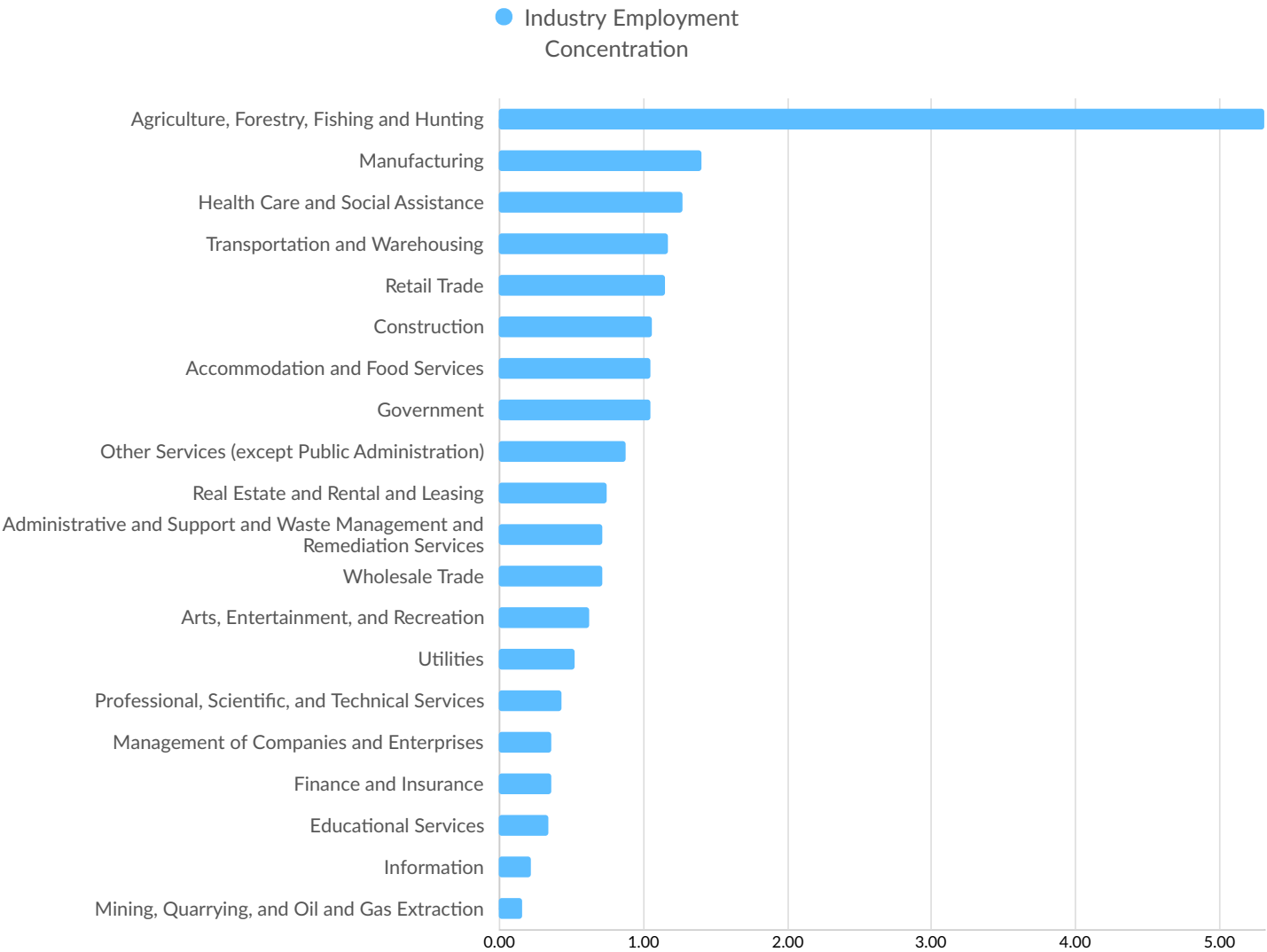
## Largest Industries



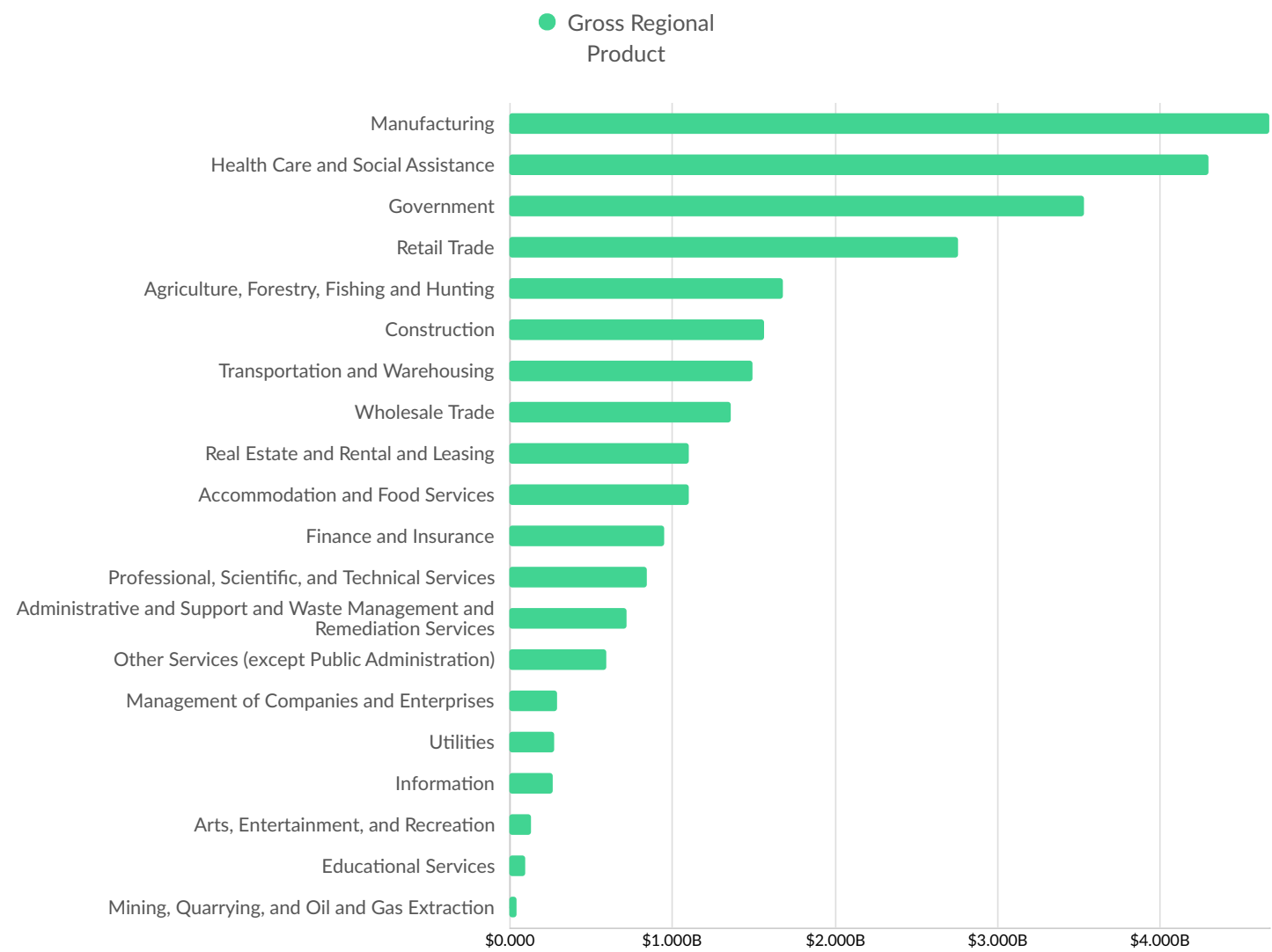
Top Growing Industries



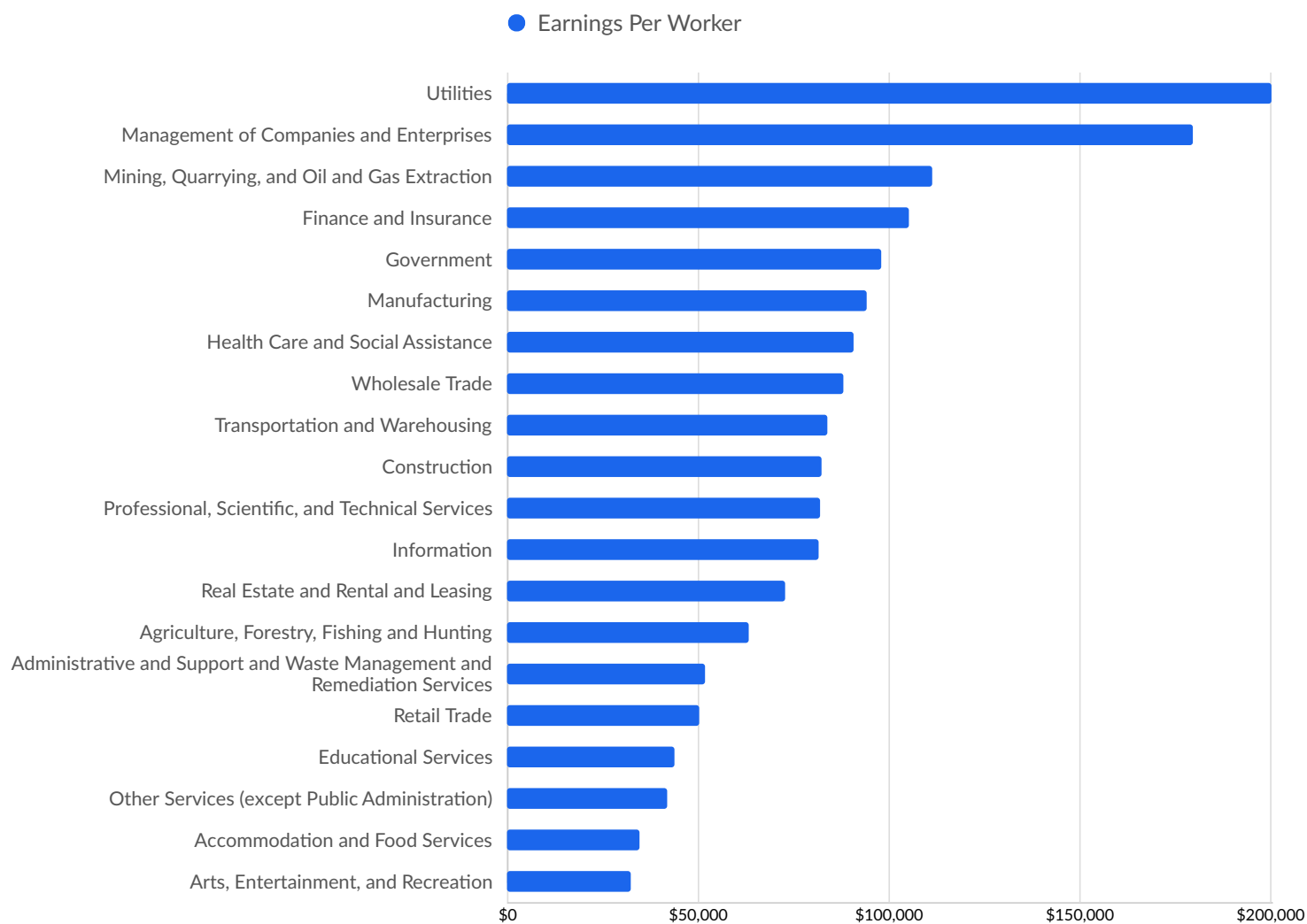
## Top Industry Employment Concentration

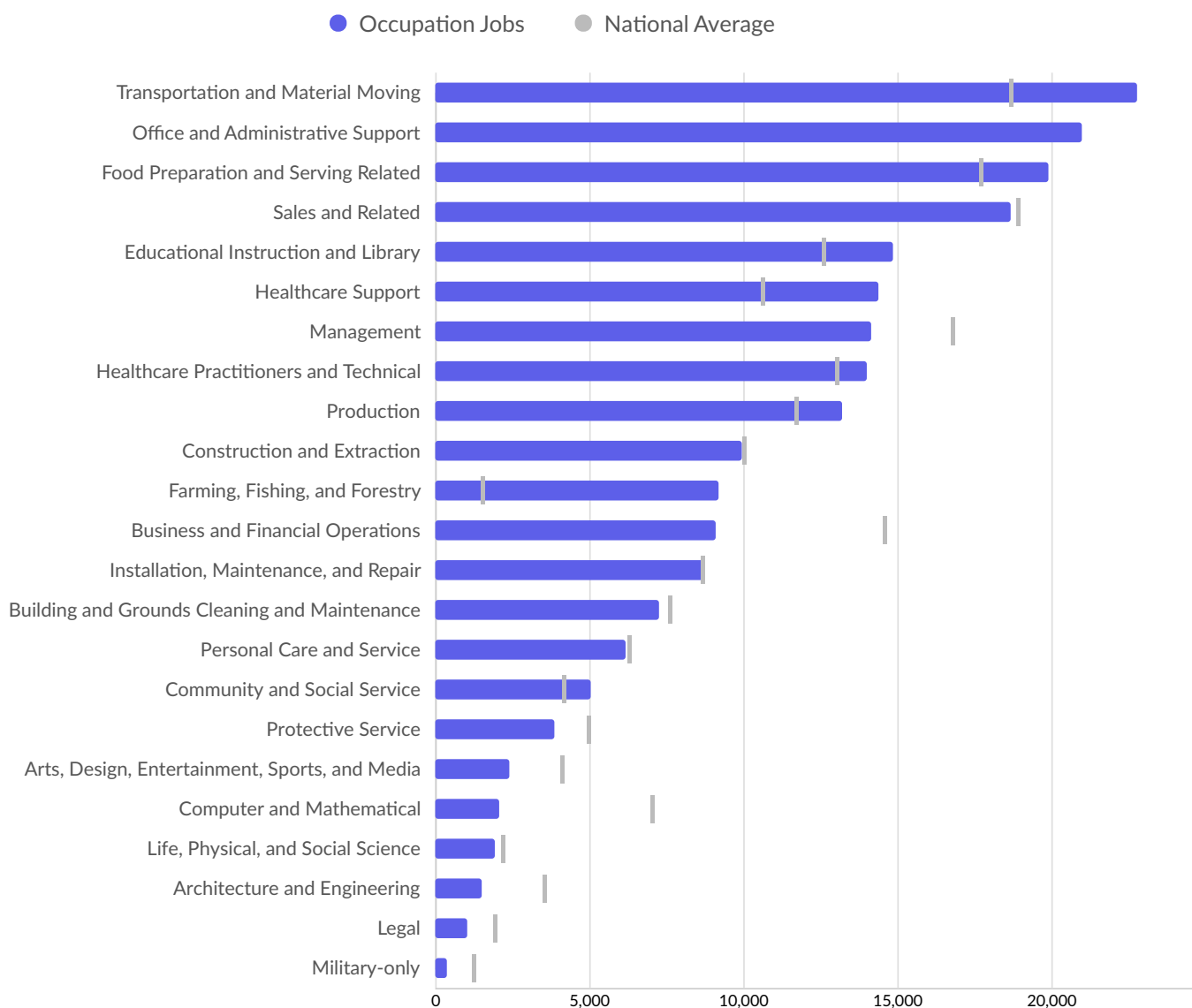

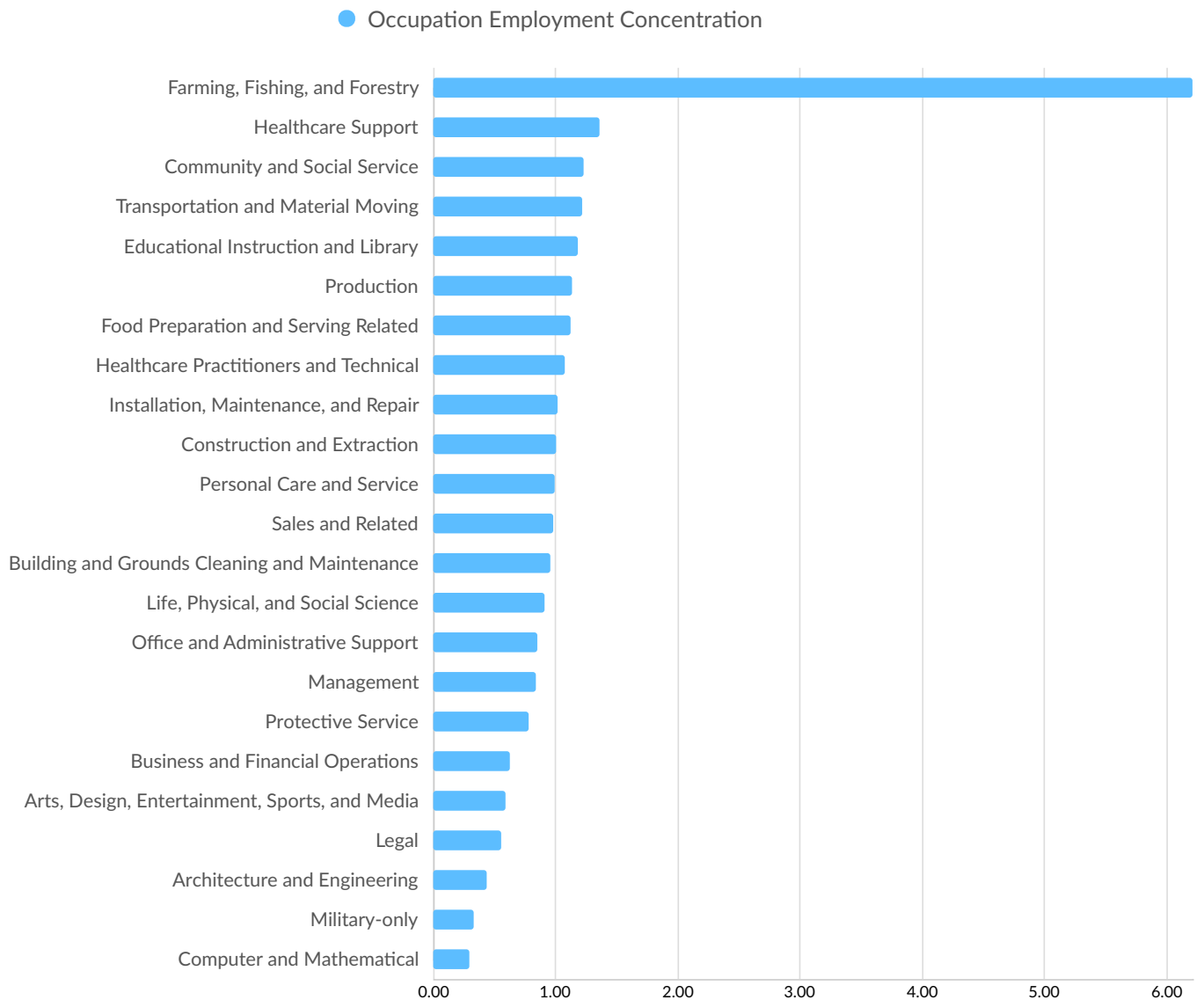
## Largest Occupations



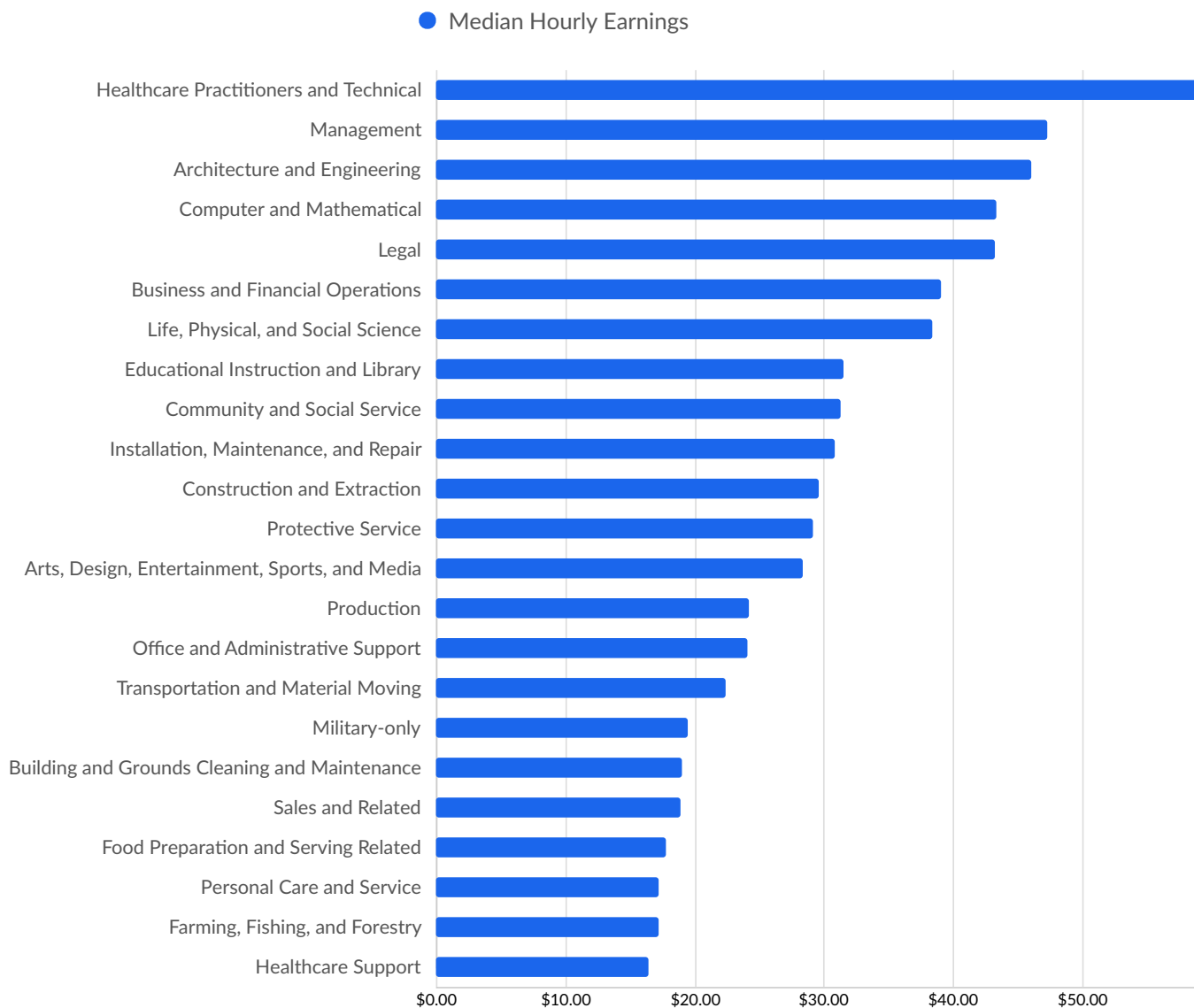
## Top Growing Occupations



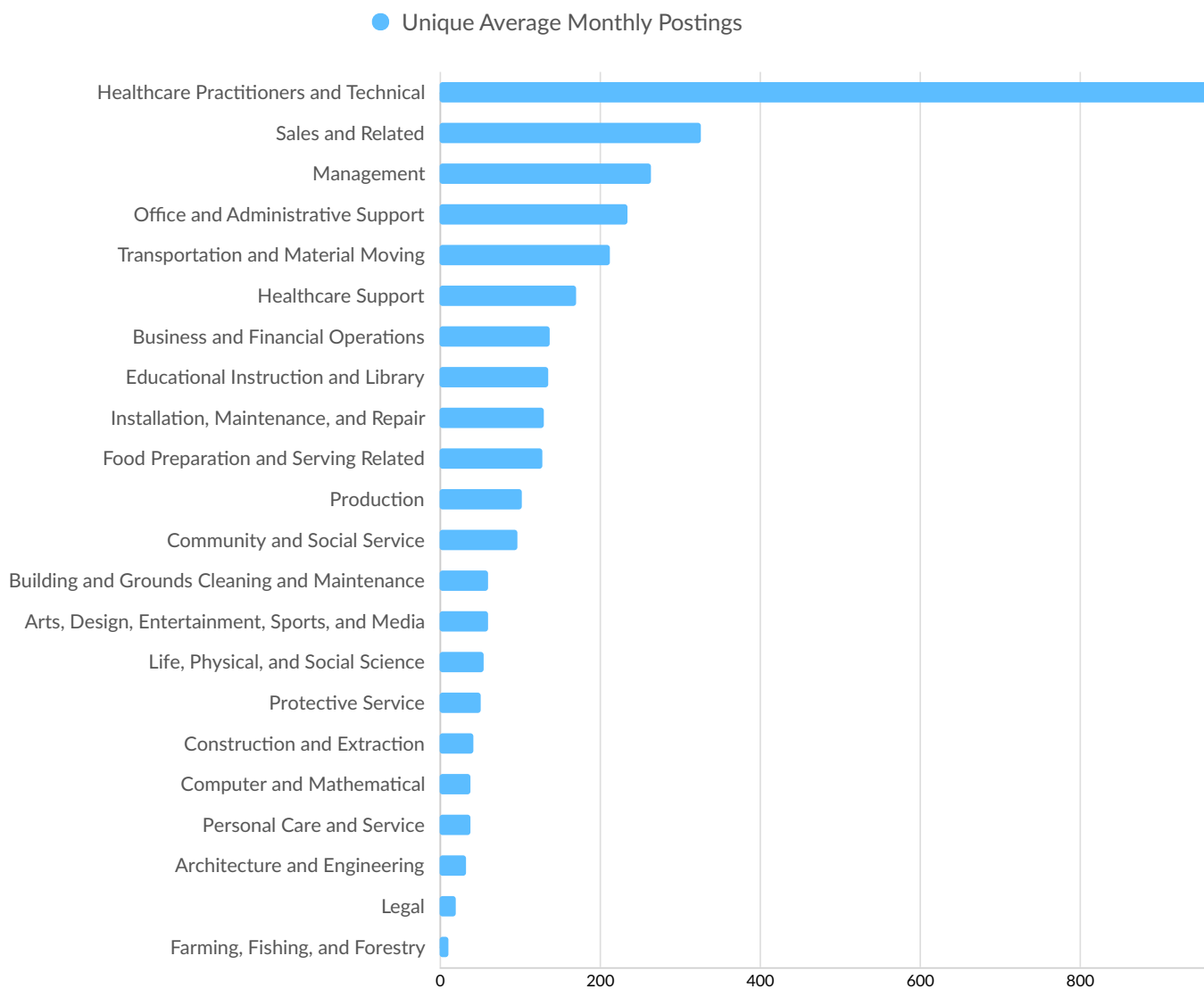
## Top Occupation Employment Concentration



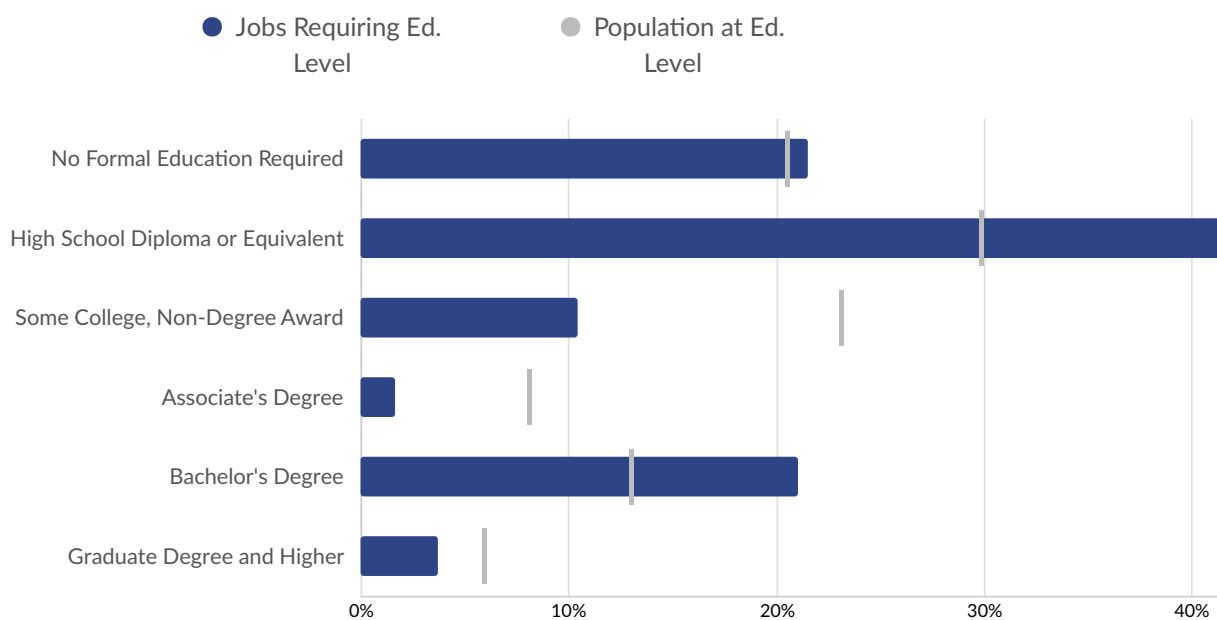

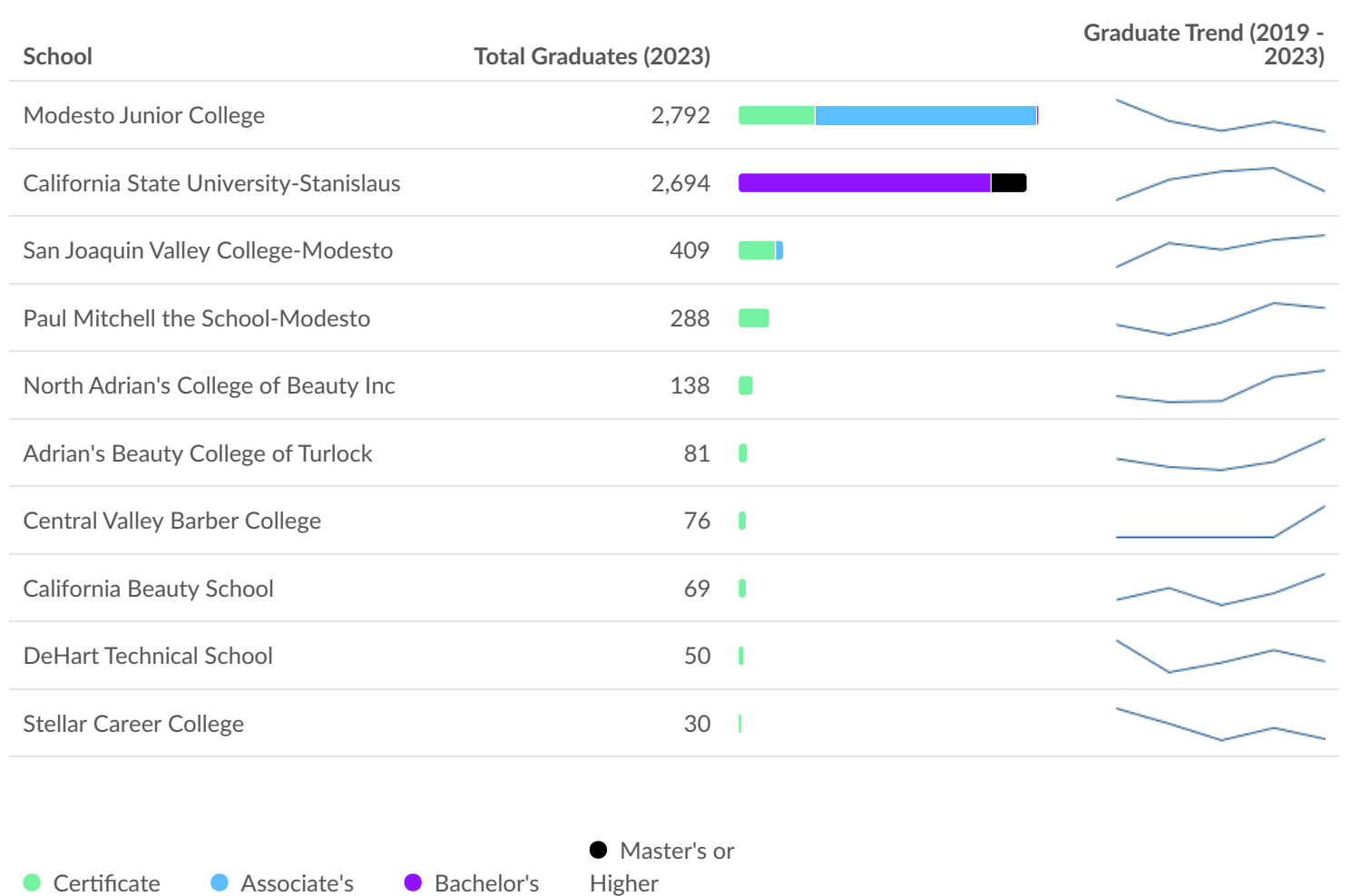
