

Light Hiring Competition Over an Average Supply of Regional Talent




Supply (Jobs)

Demand (Job Postings)


Competition from online job postings is low in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 193* job postings/mo, while there are 122 here.


Supply Is About Equal to the National Average


Retirement Risk Is Low, While Overall Diversity Is High


Retirement risk is low in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 3,039* employees 55 or older, while there are 2,705 here.


Gender Diversity


Unemployment Rate Trends

Unemployment shown at the 2-digit sector level.




Industry Age Breakdown



Industry Race/Ethnicity Breakdown






