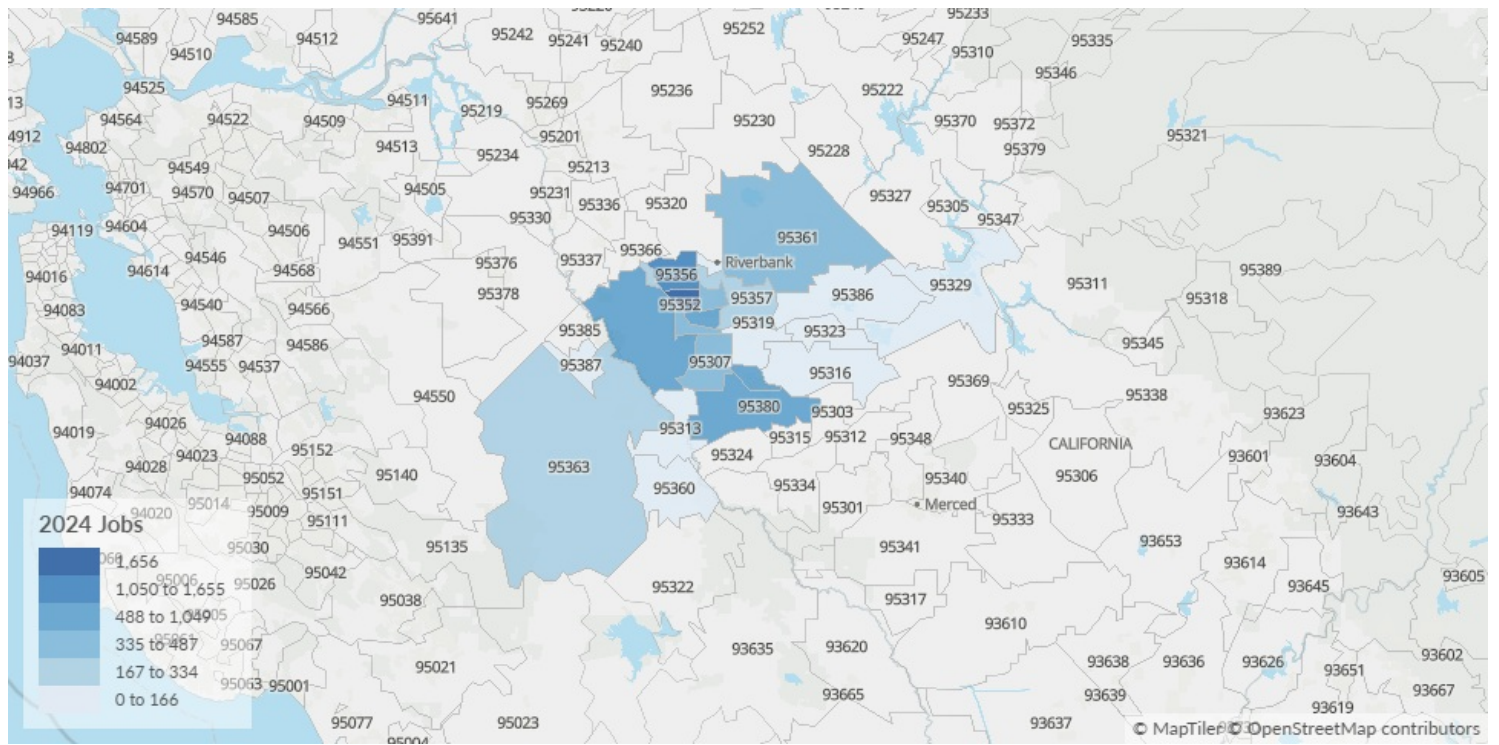

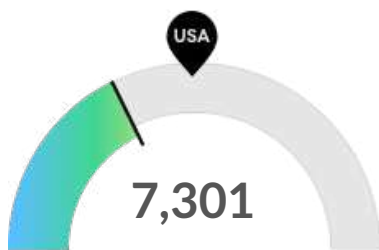

Average Hiring Competition Over a Thin Supply of Regional Talent



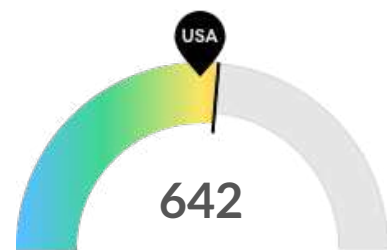
Supply (Jobs)

Demand (Job Postings)

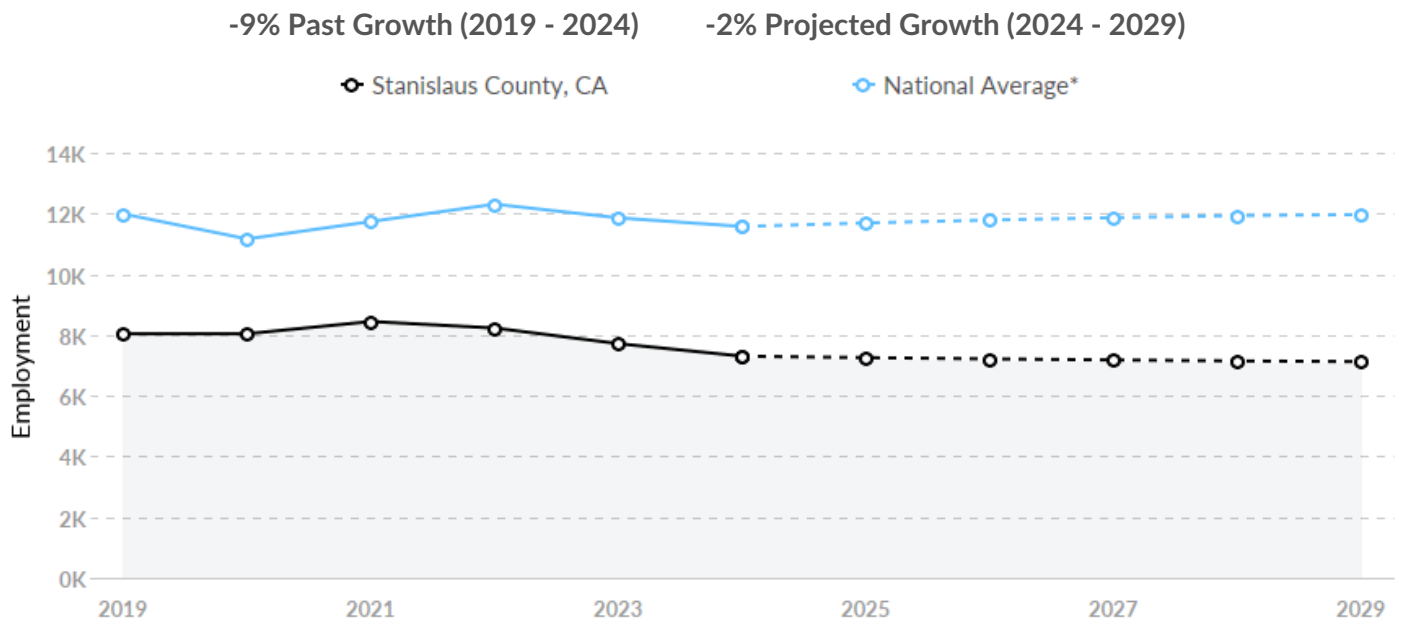
Competition from online job postings is about average in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 592* job postings/mo, while there are 642 here.

Supply (Jobs)

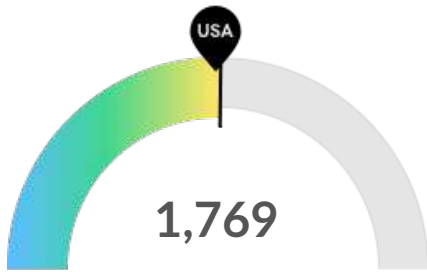
Supply Is Lower Than the National Average

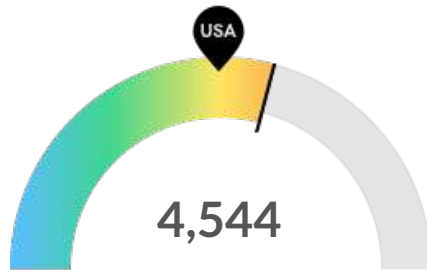

Retirement Risk Is About Average, While Overall Diversity Is About Average



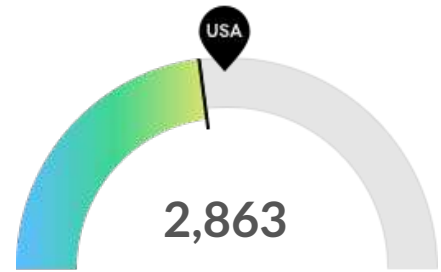
Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is high in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 3,608* racially diverse employees, while there are 4,544 here.



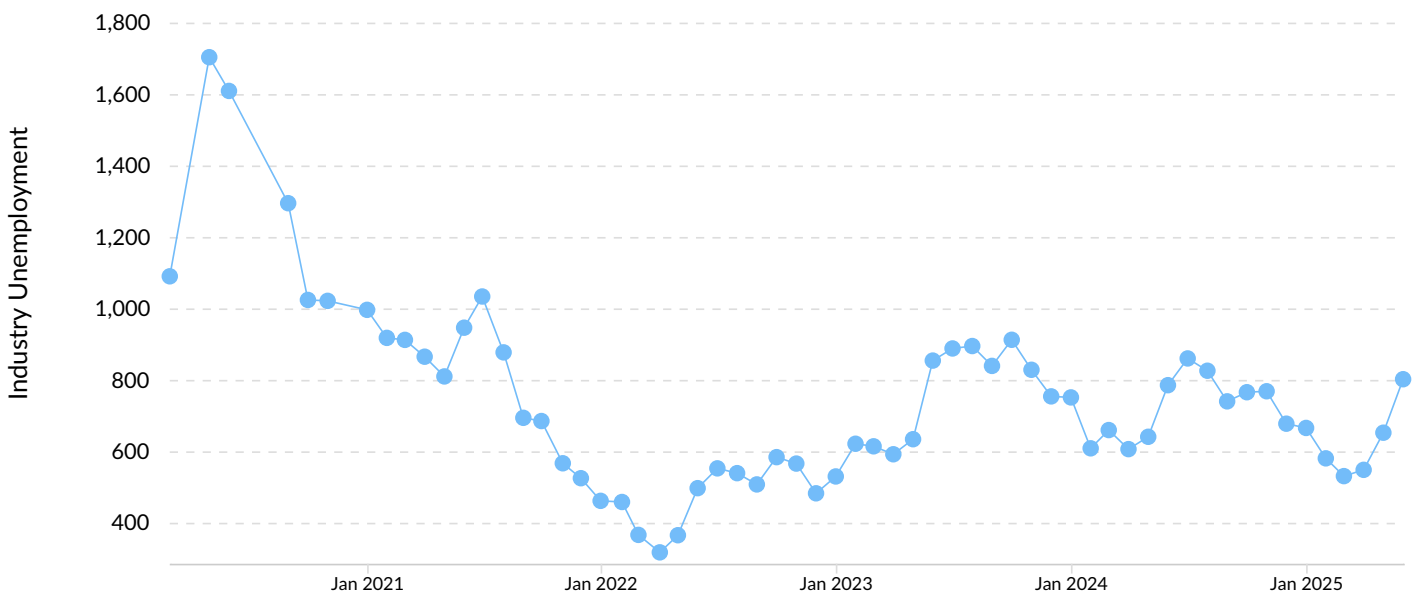
Gender Diversity

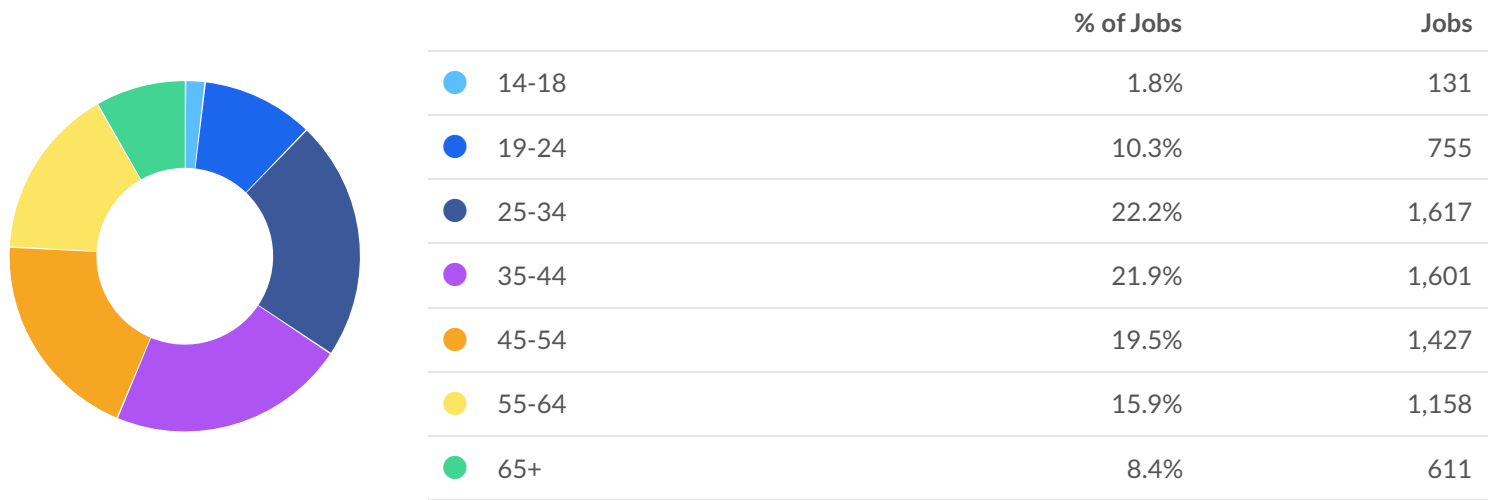
Unemployment Rate Trends

Unemployment shown at the 2-digit sector level.

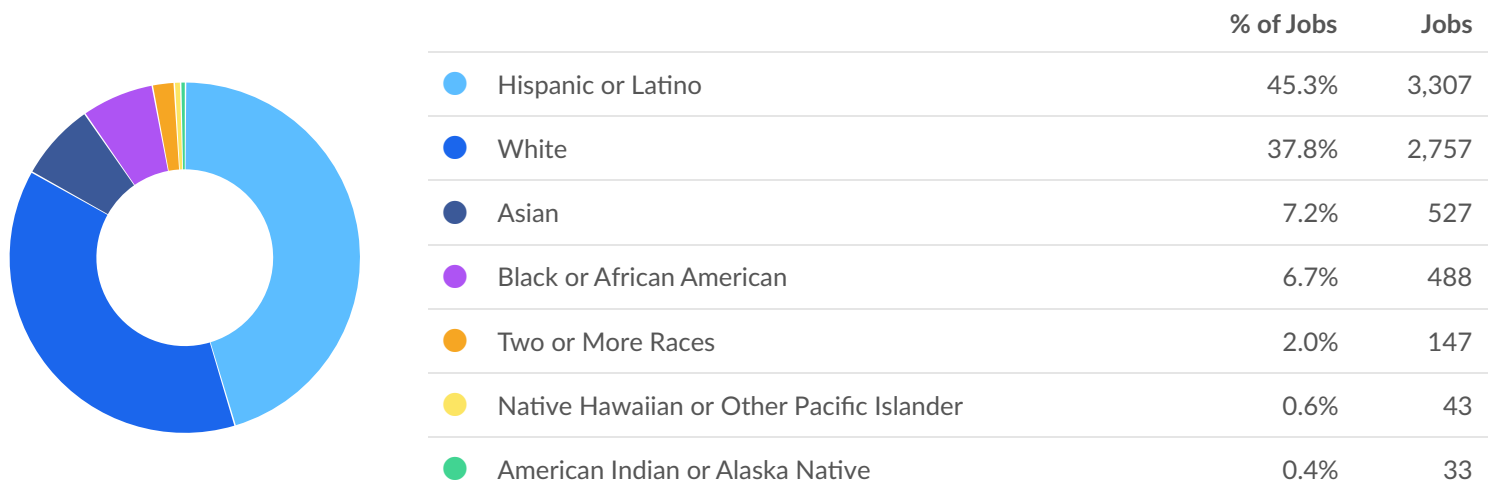

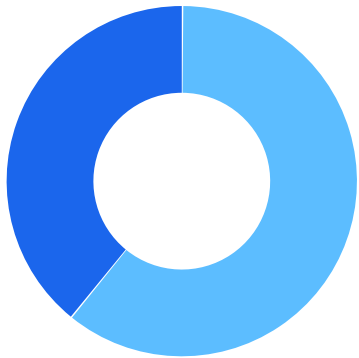
Industry Age Breakdown

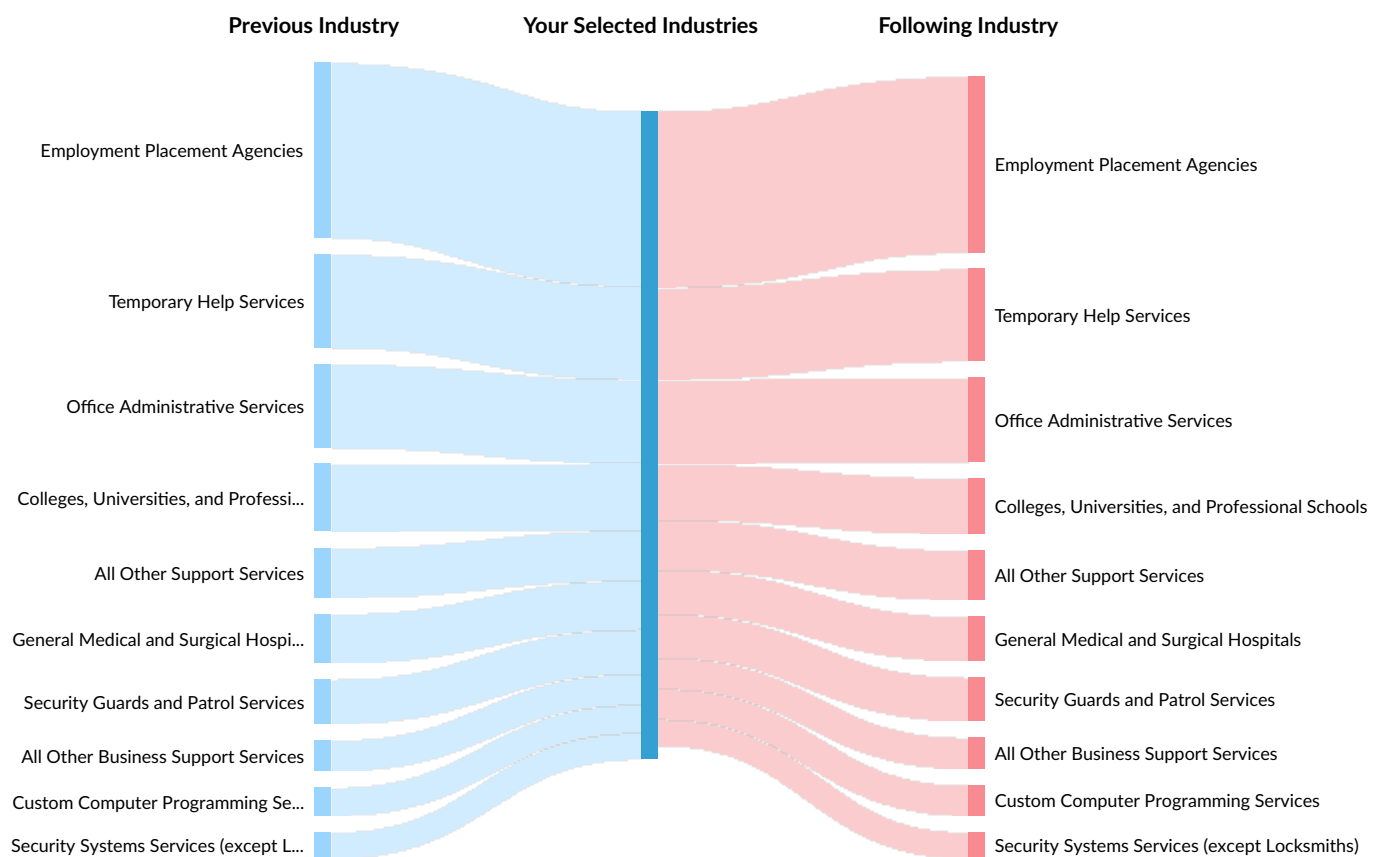

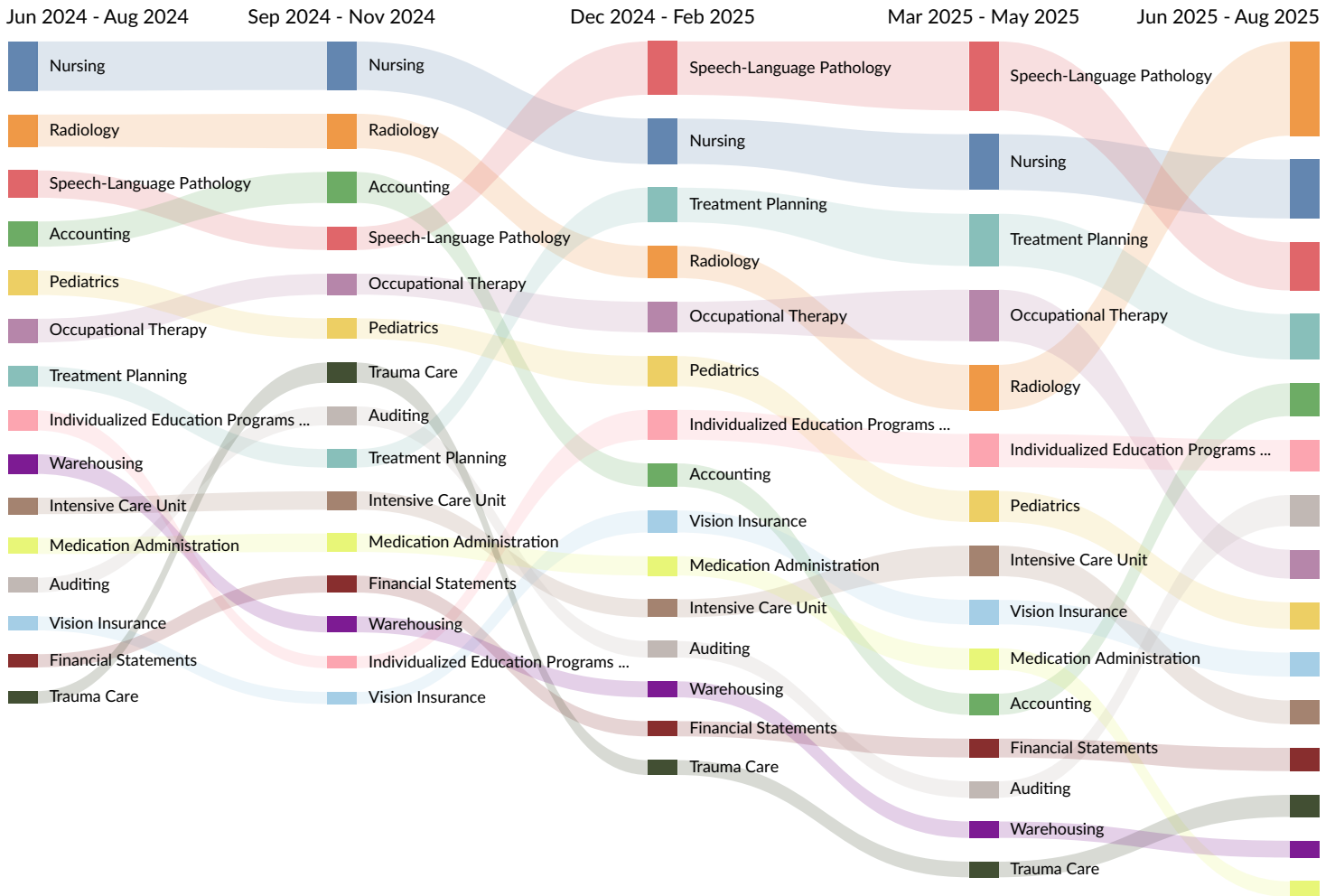

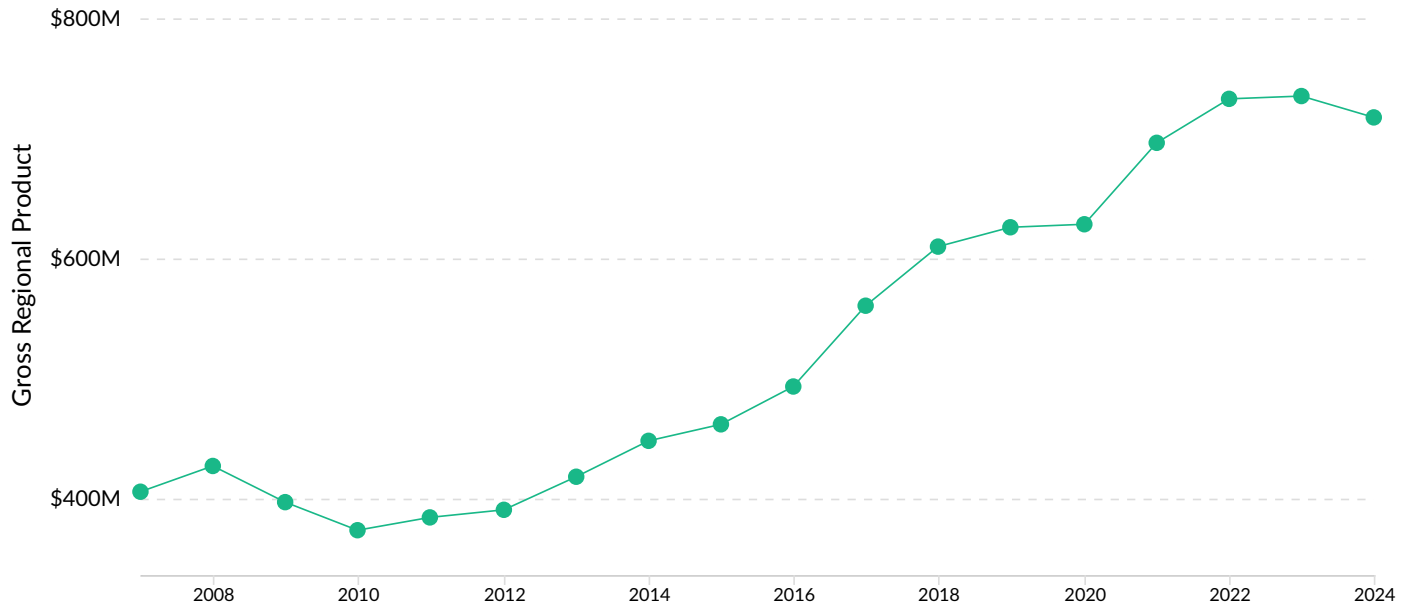
