

Light Hiring Competition Over a Thin Supply of Regional Talent




Supply (Jobs)

Stanislaus County, CA is not a hotspot for this kind of talent. The national average for an area this size is 294* employees, while there are 38 here.



Earnings Per Job

Earnings per job are about the same as the national average. Earnings per jobs is the total industry earnings divided by the number of jobs in the industry.



Demand (Job Postings)

Competition from online job postings is low in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 743* job postings/mo, while there are 615 here.


Supply (Jobs)

Supply Is Lower Than the National Average

-65% Projected Growth (2024 - 2029)





Reliable Retirement Information Is Not Available, While Overall Diversity Is High




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is high in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 16* racially diverse employees, while there are 22 here.




Gender Diversity


Unemployment Rate Trends

Unemployment shown at the 2-digit sector level.








