

Job Search Web Sites

We naturally first think of looking for jobs online at the big job boards, like Indeed (www.indeed.com), Monster (www.monster.com) and CareerBuilder (www.careerbuilder.com). Although these are great resources, job seekers should not overlook the strategy of going directly to the employer's website to search for job listings. Employers will post on their own website first because it is free to them. Remember that employers want to fill positions at the lowest possible cost.

More Specialized Searching

Niche Job Boards

In addition to searching the big job boards, jobseekers should always identify and search through job boards specialized for their profession or industry. There is less competition because fewer people are browsing these sites, and you'll see more relevant job postings with less "junk" to sift through.

To get started, search Google for job boards relevant to a specific industry or niche. Search for things like: Creative job boards, Sales job boards, Healthcare job boards

You should be able to find job search engines dedicated to specific industries (tech, pharma) and specific types of work (writing, sales, design). There are even job boards dedicated to specific types of work, like remote jobs.
